

Veterans Appreciation 2019

Gold Mountain Casino

Official Rules

1. Gold Mountain Casino is a governmental enterprise of the Chickasaw Nation, (“Nation”) a federally recognized sovereign Indian tribe. Gold Mountain Casino is giving away up to \$2,500 in cash during the “Veterans Appreciation” promotion.
2. Patrons must be 18 years of age or older with a valid photo I.D. and Military I.D. The following individuals or entities are not eligible to participate or win during this promotional activity: employees of Gold Mountain Casino; employees of the Nation prohibited from participating as set forth by any of the Nation’s policies, regulations, or laws; anyone who has been barred from any of the Nation’s gaming facilities; or any promotional sponsors.
3. On Monday, November 11, 2019, the first one hundred (100) Veterans and Active Military will receive \$10 in cash and an entry ticket for the drawing.
 - a.) Qualified Patrons must register at the Cashiers Cage to receive their \$10 prize and entry ticket.
 - b.) No game play will be required.
 - c.) Qualifying time is from 8:00am until 8:00pm.
 - d.) Entry tickets must be filled out completely and legibly with a pen and turned into the designated hopper at least five (5) minutes prior to the first drawing time on Monday, November 11, 2019. Non-legible entry tickets will be void.
 - e.) Limit of one (1) prize and entry ticket per Patron.
4. Drawings will occur at 8:05pm on Monday, November 11, 2019, and a total of five (5) winners will each receive \$300 in cash.
 - a.) Patrons do not need to be present to win. Winners will be announced in the Casino. If not present, winners will be contact by phone and given fourteen (14) days to claim their prize. Any unclaimed prizes will be forfeited.
 - b.) Gold Mountain Casino’s manual drawing system will be the sole determinant of each winner.
5. Winner(s) are responsible for all applicable taxes. Winners will receive a W2-G and/or a 1099 tax form, when applicable provided by the Chickasaw Nation.
6. Acceptance of prize constitutes winner’s permission for Nation to use his/her likeness or name for publicity or promotional uses without compensation or notice. Winners must agree to sign a publicity release form before prize will be released.
7. Any situation or dispute not covered by these Official Rules will be resolved by Nation in a manner deemed by Nation to be the fairest to all concerned. Any such decision shall be final ad binding on all Patrons. In addition, Nation reserves the right to void any entry, and/or change, cancel or modify this promotion at any time without notice. Upon any dispute resulting from game play, Patrons may file a Prize Claim with the Chickasaw Nation, Office of the Gaming Commissioner.

8. Participation in this promotion is an agreement to abide by these Official Rules. Failure to comply with these Official Rules may result in disqualification and a forfeiture of any prizes.
9. Participation in this promotion and/or tournament further constitutes the affirmative consent of each Patron to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Nation, its regulatory bodies and courts without limit to time or event, which shall govern this promotion.
